# School Telehealth

Visit with a Norton Healthcare provider virtually



## What is telehealth?

A Norton Healthcare provider can treat your child over a video call with your child's school nurse. We give school nurses training and equipment to enable your child to get the care they need without missing class and without you having to leave your work or home.

## Is there a cost?

If you have health insurance or Medicaid, the visit will cost about the same as a doctor's office visit copay. If a prescription is needed, it will be sent to a pharmacy of your choice.

## What types of conditions can be treated?

We can care for students with common illnesses such as cold, cough, COVID-19, flu, rash, fever, earache, pinkeye and sore throat.



## How will I know what the provider says?

You are welcome to join your child's telehealth visit. We also send a visit summary to you and your child's primary care provider. With the MyChart mobile app, you can access your child's health records anytime.

## How do I sign up?

Scan the **QR code** or register at **SchoolTelehealth.NortonHealthcare.org**. You need to register your student each school year.
