Types of Financial Aid

- [Federal Grants](#) (see handout)
often awarded based on financial need; does not have to be paid back
- [Federal Work-Study](#)
provides part-time jobs for students with financial need
- [Federal Student Loans](#) (see handout)
subsidized and unsubsidized; must be paid back; accumulate interest
- [Military Families Aid](#)
- Scholarships
based on merit or financial need; does not have to be paid back

- To “attach transcripts” use Skyward Portfolio or parchment.com (order a transcript for “self view”)
- Busiest time is November - April; check weekly
- Resume recommended
