success over the past several years and I want to continue down that road. In order to do that we will need kids to get involved...at the high school, junior high, and younger ages, if possible."

Conner brings a familiarity to the Cubs. He has been a part of the team for the last four years as a parent of a very successful golfer. His son, Landon, is currently attending Campbellsville University on a golf scholarship. "I have watched these young men grow as individuals and as a team over the last four years," shares Conner. "We will have the opportunity to rebuild on a very solid foundation. We graduated some very talented golfers but I look forward to our underclassmen stepping up into leadership roles and bringing on some new talent."

He was a part owner in Cozy Acres Golf Course, spent three years as the Madison Junior High School golf team coach, and has coached various youth basketball and baseball teams within our community.
