In <u>September</u>, we shared our data dashboard of things we have identified as essential elements of a proactive, safe, and engaging learning environment for all students. Each month we will monitor and compare our data to assess how we are doing as a collective whole - students, staff, and families.

As a reminder, our **attendance goal is 95%** - we improved slightly from last month but there is still lots of room for improvement, Bears!

We continue to be committed to addressing discipline referrals and

appreciate the support of our families when situations arise.

We have seen significant improvement in students with an F in a class. Last month we had 119 school wide, this month we have 95 - that is a trend we want to see continue! Each grade level saw a decrease in the number of F's with a 3% decrease overall.
