FORGIVENESS.



IREAD Information

IREAD-3 begins for our 3rd graders on Wednesday, March 8 – Thursday, March 9th.

IREAD-begins for our 2nd graders on Tuesday, March 14th—Wednesday, March 15th.

Much of the IREAD-3 test will focus on reading comprehension questions of nonfiction, informational, and literary text along with word recognition, fluency, and vocabulary development through multiple-choice items. Questions may include identifying the problem and solution, causes and effects, or the main idea in a text. Questions may also include recalling story elements such as the plot and character traits.

Please assist us by having your 2nd and 3rd grade student present, rested and ready to test during their testing dates.
