ILEARN begins for our 3rd and 4th graders on Tuesday, April 18th. We will test until the first week of May.

ILEARN assesses achievement of Indiana Academic Standards for the following grades and subject areas: English/Language (3-8 grades), Mathematics (3-8th grades), Science (grades 4 and 6), Social Studies (grade 5).

We would encourage students to come to school well rested – ready to do their best on their testing day.

We encourage students to have breakfast each day, but especially on their testing dates. Our school provides breakfast free to all students.

If families can avoid absences and morning appointments during the testing window, it would be appreciated.
