Care Solace is a 24/7/365 organization with Care Companions that can support individuals in any language to help individuals quickly find treatment options matched to their specific needs regardless of the circumstance. Care Solace is a complimentary and confidential service provided to staff, students, and their families by our district.

Care Solace can help individuals locate care regardless of insurance. They can connect to care with any coverage including Medicaid, Medicare, and sliding scale options for those without insurance.

In just three easy steps, a Care Companion can assist with Screening, Matching, and Check-In throughout the process. Or if you prefer to locate your own provider, the service offers Care Match, a self-serve website to help you find services on your own.
