APPROVAL OF CONTRACT WITH KEYSTONE ARCHITECTURE

Upon the recommendation of Dr. Studebaker and a motion by Mrs. Dugle, seconded by Mr. Henry, the Board voted, 5-0, and the motion carried to approve the contract with Keystone Architecture not to exceed \$30,000.00. Dr. Studebaker said the civil engineering cost is outside of this \$30,000.00. He said the base project for this contract is an 8-lane track, field turf football/soccer field, associated with lighting and scoreboard updates. He said if further funding becomes available, the project could include additional improvements as provided inside the contract.

Mr. Henry said the facility needs work as the track if falling apart. He said the Band will now have a field to practice on and by upgrading the facility we could possibly hold other events.
